DID YOU KNOW?

- If you go to the BVOSC <u>website</u> you can see who holds the existing club records for the club.
- There is a calendar on our <u>website</u> that is updated with events, coaches and any cancelled training days. Have a look!
- Coaches are constantly assessing each athlete and may recommend to you a change in roster during the season. As well, the end of the fall session, coaches will inform each athlete what roster they are to register in for the subsequent session.

- PLEASE REMIND YOUR ATHLETE to be on deck 10 minutes before the session starts so they can warm up and be ready to go on time. On Wednesdays, athletes must wait until the lifeguards are on deck at 5 pm before entering onto the pool deck.
