Level One Certification Requirements*:

- Complete clinics (online or face to face) in: Introduction to Swimming Officiating and Safety Marshal.
- Obtain satisfactory sign off at two swim meets for your position.
- Confirm all information is correct and your officials training has been registered at: [Swimming Canada Officials Registration System](#).

Level Two Certification Requirements*:

- Level 1 Certification complete.
- Complete clinic and obtain complete deck sign off at two swim meet sessions on: Judge of Stroke/Inspector of Turns (S&T).
- Complete one additional Level 2 clinic and obtain complete deck sign off on this position at two swim meet sessions.

Level two positions include: Judge of Stroke/Inspector of Turns (S&T); Chief Timekeeper; Clerk of Course; Chief Finish Judge (CFJ)/Chief Judge Electronics (CJE); Meet Manager; Starter.

Level Three Certification Requirements*:

- Complete all clinics for Level 2: Chief Timekeeper; Clerk of Course; Chief Finish Judge (CFJ)/Chief Judge Electronics (CJE); Meet Manager; Starter.
- Complete the Recorder-Scorer clinic.
- Obtain complete certification in three additional Level 2 positions at swim meets.
- Conduct the Level 1 – Introduction to Swimming Officiating clinic (supervision from Level 4 or 5 official required).
