Upcoming Swim Meets We are very excited to be attending away swim meets once again. In the near future we have the Mallards LC Invitational (February 25th to 27th), the Barrie Trojans Pentathlon (March 5th & 6th) and the Trials Prep Invitational (March 3rd to 6th). We are still included in the Invitational meets we secured for April and May and the high end meets happening through April. I am now looking for a fun swim meet to finish the season with. The older swimmers have expressed that they would like to go somewhere out of Province to finish off their age group swimming experience.

Free Trials & New Members During February we started offering our free trials again. I'm happy to say all swimmers who participated in our first round of February trials have joined CCSC. We have 2 new Purple swimmers and 8 new Junior Clippers. We are restarting our second round of trials this week as we were closed last week due to pool repairs.

Centennial Pool - Water Clarity We continue to have water clarity issues during morning practices. Clarity is often poor during warm-up and then improves after the first half an hour of practice. I am still able to see the black line at the bottom of the pool during this time, so I haven't cancelled any further practices.

4. Treasurer Report

Profit & Loss Commentary

- The 20k CEBA account has been “forgiven”. BDO has already recognized the 20k as revenue for Year End 2021. I will need their assistance to account for this properly (still shows on our Balance Sheet)
- CEWS (Wage Subsidy Program) – Program continues but we haven’t qualified for a subsidy due to incremental revenue. Will apply for any and all outstanding months.
- Ontario Small Business Support Grant – We have received two prior payments for this grant (30k total). We may receive a third. Reviewing the application process. Prior payment was automatic that doesn’t appear to be the case for the 3rd .
- Pool Rental – Still have not been charged yet for Oct-Dec. We’ve accrued 3k / month – included in the P&L and Balance Sheet
- Account Sweep March 1st will be about \$19,500
