### FACILITY ENTRY

#### Entry through Door 3

Competitors are asked to enter the facility through Door 3 during the peak entry times. This entrance is for athletes and coaches only – parents and spectators will enter through the main entrance.

In non-peak times or if for any reason Door 3 does not open (in non-peak times) then use of the main entrance is allowed.

Door 3 is to the left of the stair of the main Kinsmen entrance.

## WARM UPS & COOL DOWNS

### Dive and Pace Lanes

Dive lanes will be announced 30min before the end of warm-ups in lanes 1 & 10.

Pace lanes will be announced 30min before the end of warm-ups in lanes 2 & 9.

There are no lane assignments; please be courteous and share the pool as always.

### Clear the pool

We will begin clearing the pool 10min before the start of the session. Please clear the pool completely by 5 minutes before the start of the meet so we can start racing promptly on time.

### Cool down pool

The training pool (6 lanes, 25m) will be available every session, including warm-ups. Please note that for the first session this will be on the east side of the bulkhead (closest to the change rooms) and the rest of the sessions will be in the west side (closest the dive tank).

## FINAL 4 & AWARDS

### Ready Room & March out

Final 4 and Top 10 Distance event finalists will be marched out from the ready room on deck. Please have Final 4 swimmers in the ready room at least 15 minutes before their race so that we do not have any unwanted delays. All other finals (A, B, C) will report directly to the block.

### Final 4, Swimmer Bios

Bio forms will be available for swimmers to provide some additional information about themselves. This information may be used by the announcer during the play-by-play of the finals.

### Spin the Wheel

The famous Edmonton Open Wheel of Fortune will be spun before each Final 4 to determine the cash prizes for that final.

### Collecting Awards

Awards will be collected at the Announcer's Table. Please try to collect your awards immediately following your final as we would like to catch an interview with winner(s) whenever time permits.
