Athlete Code of Conduct Policy

Revised by the Edmonton Triathlon Academy Board 'July 8, 2021'.

Thank you for choosing to become a member of the Edmonton Triathlon Academy (ETA). The Board of Directors and coaches welcome you to our club. As with any club or organization, there are certain behavioural expectations. This Code of Conduct for Athletes will inform you and your parents what these expectations are.

ATHLETES HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO:

- 1. Treat everyone fairly within the context of their activity, regardless of gender, place of origin, colour, sexual orientation, religion, disability, political belief or economic status.
- 2. Take pride in being part of the ETA and represent themselves and their family's name to the best of their ability and values.
- 3. Be a positive member of the ETA and the sport.
- 4. Refrain from online or public criticism of other athletes, coaches or officials.
- 5. Uphold the rules of the sport and the spirit of such rules.
- 6. Treat competitors and officials with due respect both in victory and defeat.
- 7. Take care of their own personal belongings. Coaches and/or representatives will not be held responsible or liable.





ATHLETES MUST:

1. Participate in triathlon practices/races in a manner that ensures the safety of themselves, fellow athletes, coaches and officials.

2. Respect other athletes' dignity: verbal or physical behaviour that constitutes harassment or abuse is totally unacceptable.

UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOR:

The following are some examples of unacceptable behaviour that could involve suspension or expulsion from the ETA. Please be aware that these are merely examples, and other forms of unacceptable behaviour not on this list could be subject to disciplinary action.

- Any vulgarity, profanity or intimidation directed to fellow athletes, other players, coaches, officials.
- Vandalism or theft.
- The consumption of any drugs not prescribed by a doctor.
- No underage drinking of alcohol at any ETA practice/camp or other official events
- Any action or behaviour which would bring discredit to the club
