## Hanover Swim Club Code of Conduct

## **Swimmers**

Respect teammates, other athletes and patrons, coaches, officials and volunteers. Club expectations:

- Demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship and leadership.
- Cheer on your teammates, as well as athletes from other teams.
- Help and encourage younger swimmers.
- Demonstrate fair play in sports, by following the rules of competitive swimming.
- Listen to and follow the direction of the coaches to the best of your ability.
- Co-operate with adults in authority, including officials and other volunteers.
- Use appropriate language and act in a respectful manner.
- Positive comments are welcome; negative comments will not be tolerated.
- Actions that insult, intimidate, humiliate, degrade or are malicious or offensive are unacceptable.

## Respect Pool and Change room facilities and Personal Property. Club Expectations:

- Behave in a manner which does not result in property damage.
- Respect public property, such as the pool and change room facilities.
- Respect personal property of other swimmers and patrons.

## Parents, Guardians, Coaches, Board Members, Volunteers, Spectators Respect swimmers, coaches, officials, volunteers and other spectators. Club Expectations:

- Demonstrate the spirit of sportsmanship and leadership.
- Cheer on and encourage your swimmer and all other swimmers.
- Demonstrate fair play in sports, by following the rules of competitive swimming and encouraging your swimmer to do the same.
- Listen to and follow the direction of coaches and encouraging your swimmer to do the same.
- Support the club, coaches, board members and volunteers. Without these individuals, the club would not be successful.
- Use appropriate language and act in a respectful manner.
- Positive comments are welcome; negative comments will not be tolerated.
