

OSC J.P. Fiset Invitational – Technical Bulletin

- Athlete entrance to the facility/pool deck is through Door 3, ground level just east of the main doors. No one other than swimmers/coaches/officials are allowed on deck.
- Updates for the meet, session reports, psych sheets, and heat sheets will be posted on the Olympian Swim Club's website <u>www.olympianswimclub.com</u> under events.
- Results will be posted on boards in the viewer concourse area and on Meet Mobile.
- Heat sheets will be supplied to coaches and officials only.
- Hospitality for coaches and volunteers will be offered in the Kinette Room. It is located near the diving tank on the viewing level. Please help yourself to one serving.
- Please remind your team to use the garbage bags and recycling bins.
- Meet fees can be e-transferred to <u>finance@Olympianswimclub.com</u> or see the office staff in the Meet Manager's office.

## **Technical notes**

- A technical meeting will be held on deck at 7:15 a.m. on Friday, December 16. All clubs must have a coach representative present. The location will be announced.
- Teams must pick up their accreditations at the east end of the pool. The Meet Manager's office will be open at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 15.
- Thursday's relay teams are final as per their entry.
- Positive check in deadline is 30 minutes after the start of warm-up.
  - Preliminary scratches are due 30 minutes after the **start** of the previous night's finals.
    - For Friday, December 16, scratches are due on Thursday, December 15 at 4:30.
    - For Saturday due at 5:30 p.m. on Friday.
    - For Sunday due at 5:30 p.m. on Saturday.
    - For finals, scratches are due 30 minutes following the conclusion of the preliminary session. The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this meet.
- Please declare any no-shows to the Clerk of Course as soon as possible and at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the session.
- Cool down lanes will be in the training pool during prelims, and the west pool during finals.
- There will be prizes in various heats during the prelim sessions for the winner of the heat. The selected heats will be posted in the change rooms and on the results board before the start of each prelim session. The gift cards will be placed in the coaches envelope in the meet managers office.
- All swimmers are permitted to race with modesty wear at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the use of modesty wear to the Referee.
