Youth, parents/guardians, community partners, and individuals who are interested in youth mental health are invited to join this community forum to share your inputs for promotion and early intervention on youth mental wellness.

Each Community Forum will last for 2.5 hours and the program of the Community Forum will include the followings:

- 3. Roundtable Discussion
- 4. Conclusion of the Day and Future Plan

The findings from these Community Forums will later be shared with broader audiences through our knowledge sharing activities for education, mental health prevention and intervention purposes.
