NOTE: This is a fun unsanctioned meet for swimmers of all levels to try racing. There will be no disqualifications and times will not be official. Swimmers may start from the blocks, the pool deck or in the water.

Eligibility

1. All swimmers must be registered with a Swim BC, SNC, or other World Aquatics recognized club.

Entries

- 1. Swimmers are limited to 4 individual events plus the Chocolate Relay.
- 2. Entries will be capped at 60 swimmers.
- 3. Entry times are encouraged but not mandatory. Estimates are encouraged if actual times are not known.

- 7. Swimmer Entry Deadline: Sunday March 31st, 2024

<u>Volunteers</u>

Timers: We will need 16 timers (2 per lane) to operate wireless stopwatches. No experience required. Training will be provided on deck. Family and friends are encouraged to help out! Volunteer signup will be sent out closer to the meet.

Safety Marshalls: 2 required to ensure swimmers adhere to Swim BC guidelines for warmup safety.

Chief Timer: To help instruct timers and offer assistance through the meet.

Runner: Someone to help out on the timing desk and post results as they are published.

Starter: To work with the referee to start the races. Suitable for someone with some officials experience.
